PACKING A HEALTHY LUNCHBOX

Many products marketed as being a healthy lunchbox addition can be high in sugar and fat, and low in nutrients. Here are some healthy options to consider swapping in your child's lunchbox:

- An apple or banana instead of a fruit roll-up.
- Swap chips for unsalted air-popped popcorn.
- Include low-fat plain milk instead of drinks high in sugar such as sports drinks and fruit drinks with less than 99% juice.
- Swap sugary snacks, such as cake or biscuits, for a low-fat plain/fruit-based yoghurt.
- Use wholemeal or multi-grain bread instead of white bread for sandwiches.

With term 1 now underway welcome to all our new families. I would like to introduce you to the services available on line with FlexiSchools. The Uniform Shop - both current and new enrolments can order and pay online. Delivery options available to all include either the collection of your order from the Uniform Shop, choose for it to be delivered to your child's classroom to take home or collect your order from the office. Options on the canteen menu are available for everyone to be involved simply select Student, Staff or Volunteer when setting up your initial registration. Orders can be made for Friday Breakfast, Recess and Lunch each day. Special Food Days such as Milkshake and Donut Days, Hot Dog Days, Swimming and Athletics Carnivals when happening are available too! An alert for Allergy can be selected, also a No Butter Choice selection, up to the minute menu and pricing and the entire menu categorised by the Traffic Light System (Red, Green and Amber). If you owe money to the canteen as a Flexischools user or not you can utilise the I.O.U. tab! Place an order on the day, in advance (days and weeks ahead) or setup an order to repeat automatically! Payments and Flexischools' account top up is available with Visa, Master Card, Pay Pal and Direct Debit (EFT). The interest in and support for FlexiSchools continues to grow. As at the end of last year 124 or (73%) of the school population were registered users. This equates essentially to three in every four students are now registered and a combined total of 3,488 Uniform Shop and Canteen orders up 94% on the previous year totalling more than \$14,000 were processed!!!
