Boys Cricket match vs. Nabitac Public School

On Friday 9th March the Tinonee Public Boys Cricket team played a round 2 clash against Nabitac Public School at Tinonee oval. The team consists of: Chase, Ben, Kyle, Torin, Alex, Isaac, Callum, Oran, Josh, Riane, Ryan and Sam. Tinonee lost the toss and were sent into bat first. Chase and Ben opened the batting. Ben retired on 10 not out and batted very well. Kyle came in and played a sensible, flamboyant knock of 43 before he retired. Torin made 8 before he was run out. Alex retired on 10 not out. Oran scored a quick 8 runs, while Isaac smashed 23 off about 12 deliveries. Sam came in and scored a valuable 19 before he retired. Callum was not out on 8 runs and Ryan not out on 2 runs. Tinonee made 193 runs off 25 overs.

Tinonee bowled and fielded extremely well. Nabitac were 2 for 0 after the first over with a sensational run out by Oran and Kyle sent the stumps flying with a great delivery. Nabitac found it hard to score off some great bowling by Tinonee. Kyle bowled 3 overs with figures of 2 for 0; Oran 2 overs and 1 for 11; Isaac bowled 2 overs with 1 for 8; Chase bowled 2 overs with 1 for 5; Torin with sensational figures of 2 for 2 off two overs; Riane 1 for 6 off 2 overs; Sam 0 for 6 off 2 overs; Ben bowled consistently with figures of 0 for 1 off 2 overs; Ryan 0 for 4 off 2 overs; Josh 0 for 9 off 2 overs and Callum 2 for 3 off 2 overs. Callum and Alex kept well behind the stumps with no byes. It was a great team effort by the Tinonee boys bowling out Nabitac for 55 runs. They will play either Forster or Tuncurry in round 3 of the Brian Taber Shield.
