**Tinonee Boys Cricket match vs Forster Public School**

On Monday 26<sup>th</sup> March the Tinonee Boys Cricket team played Forster Public School at Lake Street, Forster. It was a great start to the match with Kyle winning the toss and he decided to send Forster into bat. Kyle had 2 wickets in 2 balls and had Forster reeling at 2 for 1 after the 1<sup>st</sup> over. He bowled a magnificent spell of 3 for 13 off 5 overs. Oran bowled consistently at the other end. He had figures of 0 for 9 off 3 overs. After 17 overs Forster were 3 for 65. Isaac bowled well but without luck, with figures of 0 for 19 off 4 overs. Chase bowled 4 overs of leg spin and had good figures of 0 for 15. Riane bowled 1 over for 4 runs; Torin 2 overs 0 for 10; Callum 0 for 8 off 1 over; Ben bowled 2 good overs for 7 runs; Ryan 1 over and 0 for 4; Josh 1 over and 0 for 2 and Sam 0 for 2 off 1 over. It was a great bowling performance, restricting Forster to 100 runs off 25 overs. Riane assisted in a fine run out to have Forster 4 out at the end of their innings.
