- Children under 16 years of age are now legally allowed to ride on footpaths. This is so they do not have to navigate traffic on busy roads. It is also a great opportunity to discuss rights and responsibilities of riding on footpaths, consideration of others and the dangers of driveways
- The minimum age to open an account on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Pinterest, Tumblr, Kik, and Snapchat is 13. For Vine, Tinder and Yik Yak it's 17. YouTube requires account holders to be 18, but a 13-year-old can sign up with a parent's permission.

As parents and carers, please check your child's devices to ensure their safety in using apps. Social media can very quickly become stressful and ugly when what is read can be interpreted in a variety of ways.
