On Monday 1st April, the Tinonee Boys' football team played Nabitac PS at Tinonee oval. It was a tense start to the match with both sides having a few opportunities to score. Nabitac opened the scoring and got some momentum in the match with 2 quick goals to make it 3 nil at half-time. With a few positional changes at half-time, Tinonee looked the better of the two sides with some good passing and teamwork. Chase had the opportunity to open the scoring for Tinonee with a direct but a good save from the Nabitac keeper kept the ball out. Not long after a fantastic run by Lleyton and a deft finish with his left foot put Tinonee back in the match at 3 to 1. Unfortunately, not long after Nabitac had a break away and made it 4 to 1. All Hot Cross Bun orders will be ready for collection at school on **Tuesday 9th April**.

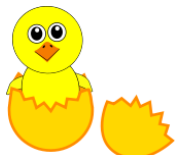
Easter Raffle
