Welcome back to School!

I have been busy over the holidays trying new recipes for our Winter Menu and am pleased to say we have some good ones for the kids to try. You can now order a **Greek Lasagne called Pastitsio**. This recipe features special beef mince placed between layers of macaroni and Béchamel sauce topped with lashings of grated cheese. (Hopefully this pasta will be easier for little hands to eat with a fork than sheets of Lasagne pasta) Cost \$3-80

I have also sourced fresh Chicken Breast to use in a healthier, tastier new **Deluxe Chicken Burger**. These burgers contain shredded lettuce and tomato, topped with seared chicken breast with either Mayo or Sweet Chilli sauce. Cost \$4-50.
