Girls' Football Gala Day- Friday 7th June



ATHLETICS CARNIVAL FAST FACTS!

- Families new to our school have been placed into a house group; Chapman (Blue), Wynter (Yellow), Gollan (Red) and Dean (Green).
- Your children may wear a plain, sleeved coloured (house colour) t-shirt (no logos) with their sports uniform.
- Children will leave school promptly at 9am to walk up to the Tinonee Sports Oval. The bell will ring early.
- The carnival will begin with a march past in house groups. Children are familiar with their house captains and have begun their house chants and marching practise.
- Kindergarten to Year 2 will compete in age races and then novelty events after recess. Depending on the weather infants may return early to school after lunch with their class teacher.
- Children aged 8 years and above will compete in running events on the day with field events taking place during sport time on Fridays.
- Our school canteen will operate at the oval and BBQ lunch parents and spectators are welcome to buy on the day.
- Please ensure your child is packed plenty of water a jumper and a school hat.
- Helpers will be appreciated for the timing of races, handing out ribbons, assisting with novelty events, in the canteen and at the cake stall.
