We were able to explore the park, seeing a variety of unique animals. Some of our favourite animals were the: central-netted dragon, pig-nosed turtle, Tasmanian devils, alligators, Komodo dragon, tawny frog mouth and the alligator snapping turtle.

We had a map to help us find our way because it was a big place with so many winding paths and hidden spots.

We saw really interesting reptiles like the Alligator snapping turtle, various snakes and turtles, Komodo dragons and goannas. We also saw a variety of Australian animals such as Dingos, an elusive Platypus, Wombats, Tassie Devils, Wallabies and Kangaroos including one type which lives in trees!

Even though the weather was a bit cold and wet we still had a great time and learnt a lot.

We recommend the Australian Reptile Park to all families.
